The following regulations shall apply to the recruitment grant of the Epsilon Nu Chapter.

I

The recruitment grant shall be awarded annually to a graduating senior or currently enrolled college student pursuing a teaching certificate. The amount will be determined by the dividend received on the permanent recruitment grant fund plus the annual fundraising contributions to total not less than \$200.00.

II

The grant is a monetary stipend to encourage students to pursue careers in the field of teaching.

III

The recruitment grant selection committee shall consist of the Professional Affairs committee and the Chapter president.

IV

The recruitment grant selection committee shall select the recipient from the applications submitted by the April 1 deadline.

V

Award winners must attend an accredited college or university. The award winner shall progress in a course of study leading to a Bachelor's degree or teacher certification.

VI

Applications will be accepted from graduating seniors or graduates in school districts where current Epsilon Nu members are employed.

VII

The grant shall be made upon proof of enrollment in college or university or to the institution so that enrollment may be accomplished.

VIII

Each grant shall be made for no more than two successive years. All funds are to cover direct school expenses only.

IX

In case of illness or other contingency which shall prevent the enrollment of the selected applicant at the next regular semester in college, the money for the award shall be maintained in escrow for said applicant for a period of one year. If at the end of one year, funds have not been used by applicant, the grant will revert to the general recruitment grant fund. When conditions herein stated are fulfilled by the applicant, the award shall be made as stipulated.

X

Guidelines are subject to review and revision when necessary by appointed committee of the Epsilon Nu Chapter and accepted by the chapter.
